on the 2 day of January, 1864, by reason of reimbursement  
to a better value

I re-enlisted on the 3 day of January, 1864, as Private  
in Co. A Regiment 22d, and was discharged therefrom as Private  
at Beltone Mar, on the 29 day of May  
day of May 1865, by reason of close of war

I have never borne arms against the United States, am not borne on the rolls as a Deserter, and have never been convicted by Court-Martial of any infamous crime.
