Pick Up Your Voter Registration application in the Library lobby or register online. In order to vote in the primary, you must be registered by 5 p.m. on April 13. (Postmark dates are no longer honored.)

The Andrew Carnegie Free Library & Music Hall is proud to serve as a polling place for the 3rd and 4th Districts in Carnegie Borough 2nd Ward.

- The 2020 Primary Election takes place on **Tuesday, April 28..**
- The 2020 General Election takes place on **Tuesday, November 3.**
- The polls open at **7:00 am**, and close at **8:00 p.m.**
- Voting takes place in the **second floor Lincoln Gallery.**
- We ask that voters enter through the ramped entrance on the side of the building. The ramp is between the main Library and Music Hall entrances.
- The ramped entrance leads straight to an elevator to the 2nd floor Lincoln Gallery.
- There is ample parking for voters around the building. There are handicapped parking spaces near the ramped entrance.

The Library's hours are 10:00 a.m. – 7:00 pm on Tuesdays. Voters are welcome to enter through the Library – stop by and visit – during those hours.

A Civics Lesson: Primary Elections take place on the third Tuesday in May, *except* during a Presidential election year, when they take place on the 4th Tuesday in April.

General Elections always take place on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November. (Every once in a while, the General Election will take place on the second Tuesday. The next time that happens will be on November 8, 2021.)
