Display Cabinet Policy

The library provides one of its display cabinets free of charge to patrons of Allegheny County for exhibition of personal collections on a first come, first served basis. Patrons wishing to display personal items in the cases should submit their name and contact information to the Library Director who will advise of availability.

The length of display will generally be one month. Patrons are responsible for setting up and taking down their display. The Library reserves the right to alter the length of the display.

Displays may not include any items or images that would be in violation of <u>18 PA. Cons. Stat. Sec. 5903</u>. The Library Director will have discretionary authority over the appropriateness of items displayed for public viewing.

The display cases are made of glass, consisting of two glass shelves measuring approximately $36'' \le 40'' \le 20''$ h. The bottom shelf is made of wood and measures $36'' \le 40'' \le 36'' \le 36'' \le 36'' \le 36''$ h. The shelves are lit around the perimeter. Lighting at the top of the case is fluorescent bulb covered with UV filtering shield. The cabinets are secured with a lock.

The library assumes no liability for items displayed in the case. Patrons exhibit at their own risk.
